Theme: Greedily amassing wealth and hoarding up treasure for Oneself is madness.

What is our attitude towards material things? Jesus gives us a warning: "Be on your guard against avarice of any kind, for a person's life is not made secure by what he owns, even when he has more than he needs." Wealth is sometimes considered a sign of blessing. For some Christians, material wealth takes precedence over their following of Christ. However, Jesus offers us a much surer way to happiness and security. The young man was self-centred. Nothing else mattered, no one else mattered. The world and all its goods were there purely and simply for him to take hold of and keep for himself. And now there was nothing else to do

but to enjoy it all. "Fool! This very night the demand will be made for your soul; and this hoard of yours, whose will it be then?"

So, Jesus teaches us that true and enduring wealth lies elsewhere. The rich and the poor both share the same common fate - they die. But to whom much is given, much is expected. In the Kingdom of God, we do not need the security of an inheritance. Our security comes from being part of a loving and caring community taking care of each other's needs. Our real security is not in the future. Genuine security is in the here and now. Material plenty by itself does not guarantee our happiness or much more our eternal salvation. 
