**Theme: In faith, we are sent to announce a
message of peace to all around us**

In the Gospel Reading, Jesus announced that "the harvest is great and the labourers are few." Therefore, He sent out his 72 disciples to all the places he himself was to visit. However, there is still a large number of people who have not heard the Gospel, or do not believe in God or accept Christ as their Lord and Saviour. Therefore, there is an urgent need for more people to preach the Gospel. However, many Catholics believe that priests, or religious brothers and sisters, are the only people who have a "vocation" to preach the Gospel.

Jesus was not thinking of priests and religious alone when He sent out the 72 disciples. In fact, in the New Testament era, there were no priests or religious as we

understand those terms today. In the mind of Jesus, every follower of Christ is expected to be a labourer in the harvest field. All of us are called today to be labourers with Jesus in the society in which we live and work.

On sending his disciples, Jesus admonished them not to allow themselves to be weighed down or distracted by all kinds of baggage; or find their security in material possessions, or status, or power and influence that they can wield. Rather, their security comes from deep within, a security that no one or no circumstance can take away from them. Jesus also told his disciples to bring peace with them to every house they enter.

What are we expected to do? Where can we find the time above and beyond earning our daily living and being with our families? Are we expected to

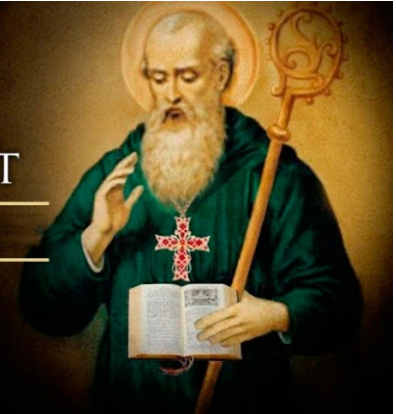

abandon our professions and take into preaching the Gospel in the streets? Certainly, not. In fact, we don't need to leave our homes to share our faith-vision, the life that follows from it, and the way we live our Christian lives.

In the First Reading, the Israelites were discouraged and had lost faith in God. God sent the Prophet Isaiah to utter words of encouragement. He invites them to rejoice because the period of mourning is over. God will comfort them and send peace flowing like a river.

In the Second Reading, Paul told the Galatians that it does not matter if a person is circumcised or not. What matters is that a person is genuinely transformed into the image of Jesus. This new person lives a life of perfect integrity and truth, a life of deep compassion and concern. Paul speaks of the peace and mercy that come to all who are transformed into the person of Jesus Christ.

One word that occurs in all three readings today is "peace." It is the peace Jesus experienced after his prayer in the garden. It is the peace that Paul experienced, even though he had his share of the "cross of our Lord Jesus Christ". So, our task as Christians is to bring peace; a peace that a close following of Jesus can bring; a peace that our society has not known, and which only Jesus can give.
