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TRINITY SUNDAY - C

The doctrine of the inner relationship of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit in such a way that each of them is fully and equally God, yet there are not three Gods but one, cannot be fully comprehended by the human mind. It is a mystery.

The fact that there are three persons in one God has been clearly revealed to us by Christ himself. Jesus spoke of being equal with the Father. Yet a distinct person from the Father; and then spoke of the Holy Spirit as a person with distinct actions of his own; whom he and the Father would send on earth to complete the work of our salvation.

The Church accepts this doctrine as it was given to her on Christ's undoubted and undoubtable authority. The doctrine of the Trinity is the basic mystery of our religion (Christianity). We accept it not because we can understand it but because it was given to us by Christ.

In our God there are three masks, three personae, three roles pointing to three separate sources of action. Those three roles are that of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

God is a loving and compassionate Father. He is easily approached and can be addressed by the familiar and intimate term "Abba" He is the Creator and giver of all life. Everything good that can be discerned in the world around us comes from him and through him. In him, through him and with him all things exist. He is cares, and forgives completely and immediately. He is the Father of truth, the Father of love and compassion, the Father of justice.

The Son is God, who in an extraordinary way came to live among us, and whom, in a paradox beyond all understanding, we humans killed. In the Son as a human being, we can see, hear and touch God. We see something of the nature of our God as Jesus heals the sick, identifies with the weak

and socialises with the sinful. We see him challenge the dehumanising values that form the fabric of most of our lives and, in the process, he is rejected by those he loves. Though he is God, he empties himself of all human dignity that he might open for us the way to true and unending life.

The Holy Spirit is God, the soul of his people. All the good that we do, all our evangelising work, are the work of God's Spirit working in and through us. Wherever there is love there is the Spirit of God at work.

The book of Proverbs speaks about the wisdom and power which God displayed in creating the world, all that exists, visible and invisible, maintaining it in perfect order.

Paul brings out clearly the doctrine of the Trinity. Each of the three divine persons has a part in our justification. We are at peace with God the Father, through the death and resurrection of the Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit continually lives in us, keeping the love of God alive and active in our hearts.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son and that the truths he would reveal to them will be those which the Father and the Son want revealed.
