# THE SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI) C

Jesus gave us the Sacrament of the Eucharist for two main reasons:

(1) To be with us until the end of time (Mt. 28:20). In the Eucharist he provides a visible sign and an effective means of him being present to us and us being present to him. He said, "Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood abide in me, and I in them" (Jn 6:56).

(2) To give us life to the fullest (John 20:20). In the Eucharist he provides a visible means of communicating his life to us so that we can be fully alive both in this world and in the next. He said, "Very truly, I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day"

(John 6:53-54).

We transform ordinary food into our own bodies but the food of the Eucharist transforms us into the body of Christ. Therefore, if we do not experience the transforming power of the Eucharist in our lives then it means we are not perfect in faith. Let us today approach the Eucharist with faith in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and experience in it God's saving power and transforming love.

The key to our being in Christ is love, love not only for God, but for every single person. Jesus said that the two ways by which it would be known publicly that we live in him would be by our love for each other and the unity which follows from that. "By this will all know that you are my disciples, that you have love one for another" (John 13:35) and "May they all be one... may they be so completely one that the world will realise that it

was you [the Father] who sent me" (John 17:21,23). We are to manifest by the way we live our daily lives the Eucharist we receive.

In the First Reading, Melchizedek shared his bread and wine with the hungry. His generous behaviour is linked to the Eucharist since one cannot celebrate the Eucharist without sharing his goods with those in need.

In the Second Reading, Paul tells us that in order to break together the eucharistic bread in a worthy manner, we must share our material bread. Every time the Christian community breaks the eucharistic bread, it makes Jesus present. Those who eat the bread and drink the blood of Christ accept to identify and form one body with him, and assimilate his gesture of love and undertake to give their lives for others just as Christ did.

The Gospel encourages us to make the hunger of our brothers and sisters our great concern.

With generosity, love, and the blessings of Christ, we must put our wealth at the service of all, so that there will be plenty of food for everybody. As long as we selfishly keep our God-given gifts to ourselves, compete with others, the world will always be full of poor, miserable, and hungry people.
