

### SOLEMNITY OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

### Theme: Unity is Strength

Today we celebrate the Feast of Saint Peter and Saint Paul, the two giants of our Christian faith. Even though they were two very different characters, with unique characteristics, we celebrate them together to show their joint efforts in shaping the early church and transmitting the faith to us. They were different, yet they were One, United in their efforts, united in their love for Christ. We must learn from them and remain one and united. Unity and Communion are at the centre of today's feast!

Peter was a disciple of Jesus and knew Jesus personally. Peter represents that part of the Church which gives it stability: its traditions handed down in an unbroken way from the very beginnings. Peter represents the pope, who is the great symbol of unity and continuity. Without his role we would see the Church break up and disintegrate.

Paul was a zealous Jew who persecuted Christians, before experiencing a dramatic conversion on the road to Damascus, but didn't physically spend time with Jesus. Paul was highly educated and an extensive writer (having given us thirteen of the twenty-seven books of the New Testament). Paul represents the prophetic and missionary role, extending the Church to furthest ends.

The First Reading talks about the brutal persecutions which resulted in the beheading of James. Peter is thrown into jail for preaching the message of Christ and the Kingdom. The miraculous release from prison symbolises that protection over his Church which Jesus had promised in the Gospel. It is significant too that Peter's imprisonment occurred during Passover week, the same week in which Jesus himself was arrested and suffered.

In the Second Reading, we see Paul's life nearing its end. He describes his own life as a



sacrificial drink which is poured out as an offering to God. Paul also speaks of how God protected him through all kinds of trials and persecutions. He knows that the Lord will continue to protect him but he also knows that when his time comes, he is ready to go.

In the Gospel, Peter's faith and acknowledgment of Jesus as the Christ was rewarded by his choice as the foundation on which Christ will build his Church. Through Peter, Jesus gives his Church a guarantee of never-ending protection. And he gives to Peter, as his representative, the powers, which he himself had received from the Father, the "keys of the Kingdom".

Both Peter and Paul had very different views on how to build the Church. The main difference was that Peter believed that for people to become followers of Christ, they should first become Jews, and then they could become Christians. Paul held the opposite view and proclaimed that if we truly believe that Jesus came for everyone, then people could become Christians without first becoming Jews or adhering to the Jewish laws.

Both Peter and Paul were unyielding in their proclamation of the Gospel, regardless of the opposition they faced. They fearlessly shared the message of salvation, even when it was met with resistance or persecution. Peter and Paul gave their lives fully to God; dying for their faith.
