**Theme: Remain steadfast in faith in the
midst of challenges in life**

In the first Reading, the prophet Habakkuk asks the question, Where is God? Why does He not protect his children, especially the most defenceless? Why is it that there are so much injustice, outrage, violence, tyranny and oppression everywhere? In response, the prophet offers a message of hope in the future, a "vision for its own time...eager for its own fulfilment, it does not deceive." "If it comes slowly, wait, for come it will, without fail." But this vision is not for the fainthearted: the one who is full of God's spirit believes that "come it will, without fail".

In the Gospel, the disciples ask Jesus for an increase of faith. This prayer reflects the feelings of some communities of early Christians, who wondered whether, as a small minority in a sea of hostility and even persecution, they had any future. It is a feeling that

thousands of Christians feel today. In spite of these challenges, we must have courage and trust in the power of our Christian faith! Our faith is a much deeper and stronger trust and confidence that our God is near us, even when He seems so far away, that he will take care of us.

However, it does not mean that with such a faith the Christian life will be free of all hardship and difficulty. The Christian life is never easy. God has promised His loving care but he has never promised a life free from pain, difficulties, suffering, or even sudden and violent death. "He did not spare his own Son." What God does promise is that, with a deep faith and trust in him, we can endure pain and difficulties, that we can accept pain and suffering, if and when it comes, for the sake of making the message of Jesus a reality in our

world. Our relationship with God is one of total and unconditional love and service. The joy and satisfaction are not in what we can give and share of ourselves. Our worship does not entitle us to get things from God, as if He is indebted to us for our being Christians.

In the Second Reading, Paul reminds us to fan into a flame the gift that God gave us. This gift of faith in Christ is “not a spirit of timidity”, a spirit that makes us anxious about the future. It is, rather, the “Spirit of power and love and self-control”. Armed with this Spirit, we are “never to

be ashamed of witnessing to the Lord,” even if it means going against the tide of social expectations and losing material, social support and security. Paul stresses the need for a living Faith in, and loyalty to, Christ's teachings handed down to us by the Church. Hence, Faith is belief in, and acceptance of, revealed truths based on the authority and veracity of God, and Hope is trust in God.
