World Mission Sunday – “Missionaries of Hope Among the Peoples”

Today, Catholics around the world celebrate World Mission Sunday. It is a day of prayer, reflection, and financial support for the Church's missionary work. World Mission Sunday is a visible sign of Catholic communion and solidarity. It is our opportunity to respond to Christ's Great Commission: “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations” (Matthew 28:19). When we give a donation to the missions, we are participating in a spiritual and missionary act of love, sustaining the Church where it cannot yet sustain itself. And when we pray for the missions, we are united with those bringing Christ's hope to the peripheries of the world. It reminds us that we are one with the Church around the world and that we are all committed to carrying on the mission of Christ, however different our situations may be.

The theme for Pope Leo XIV's message for the 2025 World Mission Sunday is “Missionaries of Hope Among all Peoples.” It encourages Christians to be messengers and builders of hope in the Jubilee Year 2025. Pope Leo asks the faithful to burn with holy zeal for a new era of evangelization, bringing hope to a world overshadowed by darkness, and to be a community

of hope by letting the Spirit guide our actions. There are three ways of evangelization:

1) By living an exemplary and transparent Christian life with love, mercy, kindness, compassion.

2) By prayer - Jesus said: “*Without Me you can do nothing*” (John 15:5).

3) By financial support - all missionary efforts require financial support to provide food, medicine, and a means of livelihood to the needy.

The theme for the 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time (C) is Prayer: Does Prayer of Petition mean we could ask for anything?

In the Gospel, Jesus speaks about prayer of petition, asking God for what we need. A poor widow sought justice from a totally corrupt judge who cares neither for God nor man but was made to yield to the persistence of a totally defenceless and resourceless widow. If so, then certainly, a loving and caring God will take care of his children. So, keep on praying.

Does that mean we can keep asking for just anything? The widow a pressing need – justice. Jesus elsewhere compares God to a caring parent. Would such a parent give a child a stone when he asked for bread? Would a parent give a scorpion to a child who asked for an egg? If even worldly parents will give their children what they need, how much more will a
