Theme: What is my contribution in bridging the gap between the rich and the poor?

Wealth is a destructive power when it is wrongly acquired and wrongly used. We live in a world which praises achievement and has little time for failure. Sadly, how we get wealth or what the consequences may be for others is sometimes not regarded as of great importance. We can be very individualistic and self-centred. The rich man in the Gospel enjoyed his wealth. He did not do any harm to the poor man at his gate. He did not drive him away or use abusive language towards him. In fact, he welcomed him to the surplus food that fell from his table.

We have no idea how the rich man became rich. He might have inherited his wealth; worked long hours over many years. Why should such a man be punished? And, even more strangely, why should the beggar be rewarded? God loves the poor. The rich man in the parable may have been a good family man, who loved

his wife and was a good father to his children; observed all the regulations of the Sabbath day; yet, as long as that poor man lay uncared for at his gate, the rich man was totally condemned. He did not know what love means.

Even in hell, the rich man could still only think of his own family and not of all the others to whom he was responsible. The rich man made no move whatever to share what he had. He could have seen to it that the poor man had enough to eat and medical treatment.

We may not be rich but, we are living in a society where wealth is very unevenly distributed. In the Church, the rich and the poor sit down together at the same Eucharistic table and they give and receive and share on equal dignity the meal and the food. It is quite irrelevant whether one of them is more intelligent, more active, more enterprising and healthier. What is important is that each cares deeply for the other and sees that the
