The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica (Mother of all Churches)

Theme: We are united with the Pope in the Body of Christ

We celebrate today the feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran in Rome because it is the head and mother church of all churches in the world. It is "the mother and mistress of all churches of Rome and the world."

"Why is the Basilica of St. John Lateran the Pope's cathedral and not the Basilica of St. Peter since he lives next to St. Peter's Basilica?" In the early centuries Christianity was outlawed in Rome and many Christians in Rome suffered martyrdom. The Emperor Constantine converted to Christianity and the famous Edict of Milan in 313 AD allowed Christians to practice their religion in public. Constantine had been given the palace in Rome that belonged to the Laterani and after his conversion to Christianity he gave it to the Pope. The Lateran Palace was then adapted to become a church and was dedicated on 9th November 324 and the Pope then lived in the Lateran Palace, as it was called, for the next 1,000 years and the

basilica was his cathedral. It was first called the Basilica of the Saviour but later was also dedicated to St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist and so it acquired the name Basilica of St. John Lateran. When the Papacy transferred to Avignon for about a century, the condition of the Lateran deteriorated so much that when the Papacy returned to Rome the Pope lived in two other locations before finally settling adjacent to St. Peter's Basilica where he now lives.

In the First Reading, Ezekiel announces that from the reconstructed Temple of Jerusalem will come forth a life-giving stream of water. He emphasised that everywhere this life-giving water flows, it brings life. In this way, we can say that the vision points to the temple of God as the source of life for all people. Those who worship God in his temple are assured of life.

In the Gospel Reading, the importance of the temple as the house of God is exhibited by the reaction of Jesus. He was infuriated by those who were turning the Temple of Jerusalem into a

commercial or shopping centre. The house of God is a place where his faithful should encounter him to listen to his word and to worship him. It cannot be turned into a market place or a shopping centre.

Moreover, Jesus justifies his cleansing of the temple by reference to his very person. He told the people: "Destroy this sanctuary, and in three days I will raise it up." Obviously, the people were thinking of the physical structure of the temple in Jerusalem. However, Jesus was speaking of his very person as the temple of God. Paul in 1Cor 3 will remind us that we are all God's temple and the Spirit of God is living among us. As temples of God, we are to keep ourselves clean from any contamination that would make us unworthy of God's indwelling. We have to avoid sin and anything that is contrary to the will of God.

Let us give a worthy worship to God by dedicating ourselves as holy temples of God.
