## The Solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

*Theme: Give your full allegiance to Christ, the King of the Universe.*

In the midst of secularism and totalitarian ideologies after the First World War, Pope Pius XI instituted the Feast of Christ the King in 1925, to reaffirm Christ's sovereignty over all humanity and history, asserting that no earthly power can claim ultimate authority over the human conscience.

The first reading tells us about how all the tribes of Israel appealed to David to become their king. God assured David that through a son of his, his kingdom will last forever (2 Sam 7:12-16). Jesus is God's reply to the prayers and expectations of Israel, the Messiah, the king whose reign will stretch from sea to sea, from the river to the limits of the earth.

In the second reading from St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians, Jesus is

described as emanating from the Father with all the power and dignity of God. Paul tells us that we have been "taken out of the power of darkness" to "a place in the kingdom of the Son...and in him, we gain our freedom, the forgiveness of our sins." Jesus existed before anything was created. Through Jesus, we are made in God's image. We are called also to reflect in our lives the way God thinks and loves. Jesus is the 'Mediator', the visible link between God and ourselves. Together with Jesus as the Head of our Body, we have a special mission to be mediator between God and the world.

In the Gospel, we see the scandal of the cross. Jesus, our King, is nailed to a cross between two criminals. On the headboard is the sign, 'Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews'. However, Jesus, through whom "Thrones, Dominations, Sovereignities, Powers" were brought into being is stripped of his glory and dignity as he

hangs naked on the cross before a mocking world. For us, this moment of degradation is in truth the most glorious moment in the life of Jesus. The moment when he gave the “uttermost proof of his love”.

As the religious leaders mocked Jeus to save himself if he was the Christ of God, the Chosen One, the repentant criminal showed deeper insight. He fully acknowledged his own guilt, but saw that Jesus was totally innocent of any wrongdoing. And he turned to Jesus, and made a profound act of faith, “Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom.” He acknowledged Jesus' Kingship. Jesus saw the genuineness of his repentance, and promised him, “Today you will be with me in Paradise.” With Jesus he entered Paradise, the very fullness of the Kingdom. The repentant criminal shows us that the Kingdom is open to all who turn to Christ in trust. Jesus reigns from the Cross, offering forgiveness and eternal life to all who acknowledge him.

Jesus is given to us as our King, but it is for each one of us to profess our allegiance to him by taking on board the fullness of his life and teaching. And, as members of his Body, we too share in that Kingship. We are called to work together to expand the reality of his Kingdom in our families, in our society and in the world generally.
