Theme: God is calling you to proclaim the
"Good News" of God loving service

In the Gospel, Jesus was filled with compassion for the crowds because they were "harassed and helpless" like sheep without a shepherd. Jesus calls every one of us here to proclaim the Good News. The way each one of us proclaims the Good News depends on the circumstances of our life: our family situation, work situation, education, personality and temperament, and so on.

Jesus called the 12 Apostles and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to liberate people from the devil and to heal every disease and sickness. The Apostles were told to go only to the 'lost sheep' of Israel and to avoid the Samaritans and Gentiles. God's message is first for his own people, and then to the others. In general, Jesus' own work was

almost entirely confined to the Jewish community. Later, of course, the mandate was extended to people everywhere. The Apostles were to proclaim that the kingdom of heaven had come near. The Kingship of God is close because of the presence of Jesus Christ. We enter the Kingdom by aligning ourselves totally with the Way of Jesus, when his thoughts become our thoughts and his ways become our ways. The Apostles were to show the nearness of the Kingdom by Curing the sick; raising the dead; cleansing those with skin diseases; and casting out demons. These were all signs of God's loving power working through them and reaching deep into people's lives. We are all agents of healing and wholeness for

people, especially those we come into contact with. We are to rehabilitate and bring back fully into our communities all those who, for one reason or another, are marginalised, rejected, despised or ostracized. The demons in our society today are all those forces which dominate, manipulate and restrict our freedom to live in truth and love. We are to cast out these demons from our own hearts first before helping others to true liberation.

Finally, Jesus reminded the Apostles and each one of us that we have received grace and talents from God without charge, and so we have to give without charge through our simple, responsible and sharing lives. God's gifts to us are free and meant to be used freely for the benefit of all.

In the First Reading from the Book of Exodus, God proposed an alliance with Israel. He reminded them of all the great things he had done for them. If they listen to God's voice, and remain faithful to him, they would become a people that he will

protect everywhere, at all times, in all circumstances. They would be for him a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. By our baptism as Christians, we are also bound by a solemn covenant with God. God promises to bring us to heaven and give us the protection we need on the way. The sacrifice of Christ ratified the covenant. God always keeps his covenant. Do we keep our own part?

Paul, in the Second Reading, reflects on how Jesus in his life, death, and resurrection made manifest God's love and care for mankind. The greatest proof of God's love and care for us is Jesus' willingness to die on behalf of sinful mankind and so make possible a new and better relationship with God.
