**Theme: Christ satisfies the hunger of every
human heart when we share**

Today's Gospel demonstrates God's loving care for us. Jesus fed the enormous crowd of listeners both spiritually by his preaching, and physically by his miraculous multiplication of the apostles' lunch of five loaves and two fish. This miracle shows the Divinity of Jesus, the providing care of God, and the compassion of Jesus for the crowd.

Jesus and his companions were going to a lonely place to rest and pray. However, a large crowd of people followed them on foot. Jesus was moved with deep compassion and he began to heal the sick among them. Are we always filled with compassion for those who ask for help? How many real opportunities for bringing some wholeness into people's lives have

been missed because the requests were made in conflict with our plans? Are we people who cannot say No, yet resentful?

When it was evening, the disciples came to Jesus and said, "This is a lonely place, send the crowds away to buy food for themselves." Jesus answered them, "They need not go away; you give them something to eat." The disciples replied, "we have only five loaves and two fish."

Jesus teaches us self-confidence and urges us to share the little we have with total generosity. Jesus took the bread and fish, prayed to His Father. He broke the bread and gave it to his disciples to distribute. The crowd "all ate as much as they wanted" and there were 12 full baskets left over. The 12 baskets represent the 12 tribes of Israel, the 12 Apostles who will become the

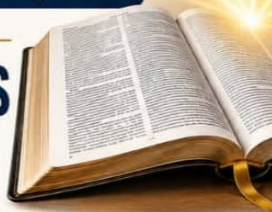

for his people.

In the first reading, Isaiah consoles the Jewish exiles in Babylon, assuring them of their return to their homeland and promising them that Yahweh their God alone can, and will, provide for their spiritual and physical needs. He will pardon their sins and will offer them participation in His eschatological banquet. God invites "everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price." Yes, if we really listened to the Lord, especially to the Lord Jesus in the Gospel, we would discover that there are ways for everyone to have their needs satisfied in abundance.

In the second reading, Paul argues that since God's love for us is infinitely immense that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities nor anything in creation, will separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

In conclusion, God really cares for his people. There is enough and more for everybody. A great deal of God's care and compassion lie on our own shoulders. A great deal of human suffering in the world has been caused by human agencies and can be relieved by human agencies. Jesus did not feed the crowd directly. He left that to his disciples. He still does. The meaning of the Eucharist we celebrate is that we commit ourselves to share, to work with God in communicating his compassion to all. God needs our co-operation to show people just how caring he really is.
